During the implementation of activities in 2018, RHNK faced some challenges, including:

- Widespread stigma associated with abortion in our communities' hindered women's access to safe abortion services and information.
- Kenya still lacks safe abortion standards and guidelines which is a barrier towards provision of safe abortion services in the country.
- Insufficient medical supplies occasioned by budget constraints.
- Second trimester clients who present themselves with complications were not effectively managed by our providers since they did not have the capacity.
- Strong existing opposition (faith based organizations and individuals) affected the confidence of providers, especially during the government-imposed ban on Marie Stopes Kenya.
- Fear of harassment, intimidation and prosecution amongst providers.

Looking forward towards 2019, RHNK will focus its efforts on:

- Coordinate the launch of the SheDecides Kenya local movement together with other likeminded organizations.
- Recruit and train more abortion providers on Value Clarification and Attitudes
 Transformation (VCAT) and Comprehensive Abortion Care (CAC) while providing legal education, protection and representation to providers.
- Collaborate with like-minded organization to monitor opposition.
- Strengthen RHNK's community engagement strategies for demand creation and stigma reduction.
